Just back from his sell out world-tour, Galea says he learnt his craft from a professional card shark at the age of 14, and he continues to defy the old-style magician stereotype – indeed, you won't find the tux and top hat or any tacky props here! In trademark tee-shirt, jeans and sneakers, the engaging 27-year-old performer brings an edge to the medium like no other, making this unique show a night of high-energy interactive theatre.

"I don't try to convince people what I do is real. There are heaps of magicians that want to persuade people they have special powers. I wanted to break apart from the 'rabbit out of hat' cliché associated with magic," he tells *SX*. "I find people are over the mysterious and hackneyed magic presentations, so this show's much more laid back and a lot more fun, and I'm pumped to be playing my home town, Sydney.
